OFFICE HOURS: Tuesday and Thursday from 10am until 12nn and 1:00pm until 4:00pm.

MASS SCHEDULE: Thursday—12:05 pm; Sunday—8:00 am.

Holy Day of Obligation—6:30 pm.

BAPTISMS: Parents must call the parish office to set up a meeting with the Administrator before registering for the baptism of a child. Baptisms are usually celebrated second Saturday of the month on Jan, Feb, May, Jun, Jul, Aug, Sep, and Nov at 7:00 pm. The parent(s) and godparent(s) must participate in a Pre-Baptismal class.

CONFESSIONS: Sunday at 7:15am—7:45am in English or Spanish or by appointment.

MARRIAGES: Please contact the Administrator no less than six (6) months before the anticipated marriage date in order to begin preparations. In addition to several meetings with the pastor, diocesan guidelines call for participation in two programs such as Pre-Cana and Natural Family Planning.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office when a family member of the parish is sick and needs this sacrament.

C.C.D. (CATECHISM)—SEPTEMBER THRU APRIL:

Sunday: **Grades 1 thru 3:** 9:15 am-11:00am in parish hall.
Grades 4 thru 12*: 9:15 am-11:00am in parish hall.
*1st Communion Preparation for Grades 6 to 12.

Youth Confirmation Program: 9:15 am-11:00 am in hall behind the church.

8:00 AM SUNDAY MASS ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL CCD STUDENTS

ADULT RELIGIOUS EDUCATION; S1: Sep to Dec/S2 Jan to Apr Thursday: 7pm—9pm in parish hall when enrollment permits.

FIRST EUCHARIST, FIRST PENANCE AND CONFIRMATION: The diocesan requirements for these sacraments mandate a consecutive two-year program in religious education. Parents are also required to participate in a two-year program.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: It is the parents who have the first and primary responsibility for educating their children in faith. The Church seeks to help them meet this responsibility, but circumstances may dictate a greater or lesser degree of Church involvement. Parents can meet with the pastor to discuss how they may go about meeting this obligation before God and how the Church can help them.
