 **The Child must be seven years old by September 1stin order to register for First Holy Communion Classes
- ** Sponsors (padrinos) are not required for students making their First Communion.

Students wanting to make their Confirmation must present the documentation above along with the following documentation:

- ✓ Copy of Reconciliation Certificate (official document)
- ✓ Copy of First Communion Certificate (official document)
- ✓ A sponsor (padrino/madrina) who is Catholic and is in good standing with the Catholic Church.
 - ** The candidate must be 14-years-old by September 1st in order to register for Confirmation classes.

The sponsor must provide copies of the following documentation:

- o Catholic Marriage Certificate (if living with a spouse)
- o Copy of their Catholic Baptismal Certificate
- o Copy of their Catholic Confirmation Certificate

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>...** A person who is living with a mate cannot be a sponsor if they are not married through the Catholic Church
