Assesses the needs of diocesan youth and young adults, including College Campus Ministry.

- Provides leadership formation and directs the overall training component of Youth Ministers.
- Responsible for setting youth and young adult ministry goals and models of effective ministry.
- Coordinate and supervise diocesan conferences for youth, Middle, High School and Young Adults.

- Promote and supervise activities for youth and young adult faith formation.
- Undertakes activities which promote youth ministry and young adult faith development.
- Promote, offer and supervise youth faith formation in the diocesan parishes.
- Coordinate diocesan events that promote youth and young adult evangelization and faith formation.
- Ensures compliance with Safe Environment policies related to youth and young adult Ministry.
