Baptism Policy Update:

Moving forward, all parishioners wanting to receive the sacrament of baptism for themselves, or their children will need to call to make an appointment with Fr. Gustavo first. If you are attending Mass at a different parish, you will need a signed letter from that priest stating you are in good faith.

<u>Reminder About Eucharist:</u>

If you receive the Eucharist by hand, please make sure you consume it in front of the priest. Please do not walk off with it in your hand or make the sign of the cross first. Welcome to St. Joseph Catholic Church Come by and register with us at the PARISH OFFICE if you are not already registered.
Requirements to receive Sacraments:
For Baptism, a copy of the child's birth certificate is required. For the sponsor(s) an updated copy of their sacraments is required and can be obtained from the Church they were baptized in. If a sponsor is married, they must be married through the Catholic Church. A baptism class must be taken by the parents and sponsor(s) and is available upon request.
For First Communion, the child must attend two (2) years preparation in catechism classes. No sponsor is allowed.

For Confirmation, the child must attend two years preparation in catechism classes and requires that they have one sponsor, male or female, who has completed all their sacraments. *For Weddings,* must call the office six months in advance to make arrangements for preparation. Wedding preparation begins with a face-to-face meeting with the priest.
