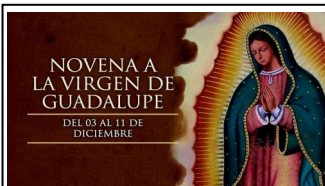

NOVENA
¿Cuál es la diferencia entre la Virgen María y Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe?

La Virgen María se refiere a María, la Madre de Jesús. Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe se refiere a la aparición específica de la Virgen María que experimentó Juan Diego en la Ciudad de México en el siglo XVI. Nos preparamos para su fiesta rezando la Novena. La Novena, es una forma privilegiada de orar porque nos permite tomar tiempo para la oración: para poner una situación difícil a los pies del Señor por medio de la Virgen María, confiarle con devoción una intención particular, preparar nuestros corazones para recibir sus gracias, acoger al Espíritu Santo para que nos ayude a discernir cosas buenas y malas en nuestra vida. La Virgen de Guadalupe no está sola, lleva en su vientre a Jesús, colabora con él mostrando su mensaje de amor, de misericordia y de compasión para todas las personas, se trata de un mensaje de reconciliación y de paz; es lo que busca que se lleve a cabo, de una forma efectiva.



IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

On December 8, we honor Mary, our Mother. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is a Catholic feast celebrating Mary's conception without sin. Even though this feast day occurs in the liturgical season of Advent, which prepares for the birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Immaculate Conception refers to the conception of Mary in the womb of her mother, St. Anne. The dogma of the Immaculate Conception asserts that, "from the first moment of her conception, the Blessed Virgin Mary was, by the singular grace and privilege of Almighty God, and in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of Mankind, kept free from all stain of original sin."

The observance of this feast began with a Papal encyclical by Pope Pius IX on December 8, 1854. Several years later, in 1858, the Blessed Mother gave her name to St. Bernadette at Lourdes stating, "I am the Immaculate Conception."

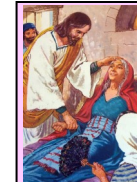
