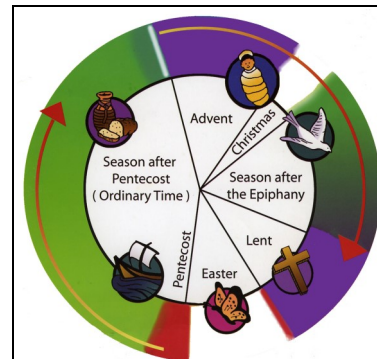

OUR STRATEGIC GOAL
 As a Church, we now move into Ordinary Time. "Ordinary" comes from the Latin root for "order," which is why we line the Sundays up on the calendar and count them—with "ordinal" numbers—one by one. The orderly way we proceed through the liturgical year reminds us that our faith offers a strategic goal for

our lives: eternal happiness with God, who is love. Today's readings share stories of believers who order their daily activities toward the goal of sharing God's love. Isaiah embraces his role as God's servant and works to bring glory not only to Israel, but to the entire world. In a similar way, Saint Paul identifies himself as Christ's witness in the world and reminds the Corinthians of their life goal: "to be holy." The Gospel shows us John the Baptist, servant and witness, attentive to God's loving orders, the divine plan for salvation.

RETIRO ESPIRITUAL PARA LOS SACERDOTES

Desde el lunes 16 de enero hasta el viernes 20 de enero de 2023 todos los sacerdotes diocesanos de la Diócesis de Laredo participarán en su retiro anual. El retiro espiritual está dirigido a nosotros, los sacerdotes que deseamos vivificar nuestra consagración sacerdotal y revivir la gracia del sacramento del orden en nuestras vidas. Las actividades diarias incluyen varias **predicaciones**, con el fin de acompañar a los sacerdotes en su ejercicio espiritual. Tomando como punto de referencia la **Sagrada Escritura**, cada meditación propone una oración introductoria, puntos a desarrollar durante la oración personal y un coloquio con el Señor para llegar a las resoluciones de la vida espiritual. **La oración** es el medio para comunicarse con Dios, donde Él mismo nos habla al corazón. El retiro dedica amplios tiempos para el silencio y el recogimiento para que cada sacerdote pueda profundizar su relación con Dios. **La Eucaristía** es el sacramento que hace presente la Persona de Jesucristo y su sacrificio redentor. El retiro lo hace el centro de la jornada y propone a todos los sacerdotes que concelebrén juntos. La divina presencia real del Señor es el primer fundamento de la devoción y el culto al Santísimo Sacramento. El retiro propone **la adoración** y la bendición eucarística como la más alta expresión de la fe. Durante el retiro, se proponen tiempos para rezar juntos la **liturgia de las horas**. La oración oficial de la Iglesia, es un momento de comunión sacerdotal. El retiro ofrece la posibilidad de tener un diálogo con un sacerdote a disposición (acompañamiento espiritual) para discernir las mociones interiores del Espíritu Santo, la oración personal y la vida interior, la integración con la vocación y la transformación en Jesús a través de los consejos evangélicos.

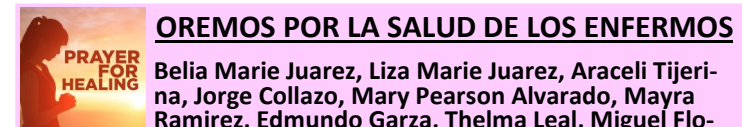
