



Saturday, June 6th and Sunday, June 7th, Our Lady of Guadalupe will open its door to the public after several weeks of being under quarantine. There will be a few rules that will be in place. Masks **MUST** be wore while in the church, everyone must keep 6 ft apart, there will only be 3 people to a pew allowed, and again 6ft apart, skipping every other pew. During Communion, again keep 6ft apart. There will be hand sanitizer available however if you have your own, then please use yours. These procedures must be followed from first entering the church until you leave the building. Help us by following the rules, this is new to everyone and will take some adjusting and getting use to. All regulations are outlined in Bishop Tamayo's memo, which is posted on the doors of the church.

Come Holy Spirit

The Spirit calls us to repentance, to turn our lives around; He calls us to Faith and to take up our cross and follow Jesus. Whenever we look to the Holy Spirit, He is within us as our Helper, always assisting us to be what God made us to be. The Holy Spirit helps us to be truly great by becoming servants to one another. Likewise, the Spirit deepens our awareness of Jesus loving us as he lives in our lives; He gathers us around the cross of Jesus; He changes our lives, helping us to be more patient and forgiving, to seek new beginnings in our relationships with one another and to let the power of God's love have the final say over the conflicts and difficulties we get into. He is available to us every moment of every day as we face the choices between being self-centered or being the God-centered people, the Spirit has called us to be in Christ.


