¿Por qué Santa Cecilia es patrona de los músicos?

El Papa Gregorio XIII, en 1594, nombró a Santa Cecilia patrona de los músicos porque había mostrado un amor especial hacia los acordes melodiosos, los que llegado el momento, le recordaron la belleza de la creación y le ayudaron a elevar el alma a Dios.

Santa Cecilia poseía un espíritu sensible y apasionado por la música, por lo que su nombre ha quedado atado a este arte para siempre.

En marzo de 2014, el Papa Francisco se refirió a los mártires de los primeros tiempos cristianos que, como Santa Cecilia, “llevaban siempre con ellos el Evangelio: ellos llevaban el Evangelio; ella, Cecilia, llevaba el Evangelio. Porque precisamente nuestro primer alimento es la Palabra de Jesús, lo que nutre nuestra fe”.

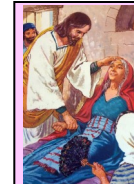

Make this a Eucharist-centered Advent



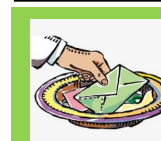
