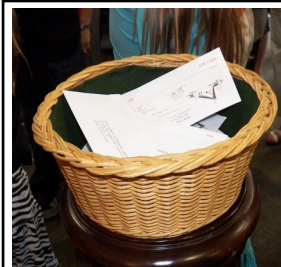

In family life, we have many opportunities to show love in action. Each time we postpone a task to tend to the needs of another, we show ourselves to be on the path to following the example of love shown to us by Jesus. Sometimes the sacrifices we are called upon to make for others are small. But these small choices to love and to serve others prepare us for the larger choices and sacrifices that we may be called upon to make. If we are people who have practiced showing our love for others with generosity, we will also be people who are willing to lay down our lives for those we love.

As you gather as a family, talk about the meaning of the word *generosity*. Ask each family member to describe an action that shows generosity. To be generous is to give freely to others without counting the cost. Recall that generosity is one of the Fruits of the Holy Spirit. Introduce today's Gospel reading by saying that Jesus taught us to be generous in showing our love for one another. Read together today's Gospel, John 15:9-17. What examples did Jesus give to us that show this kind of love? (washing his disciples' feet; accepting death on the cross) Jesus helps us to show this kind of love to others. In today's Gospel, Jesus promised that God will give us whatever we ask for. One of the things we can ask for from God is a generous spirit so that we can love others as Jesus did. Conclude in prayer together by praying Saint Ignatius of Loyola's Prayer for Generosity.

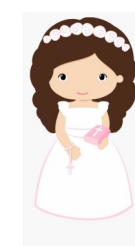
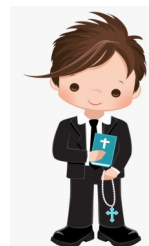

Cada vez que posponemos una tarea para atender las necesidades de otro, nos mostramos en el camino de seguir el ejemplo de amor que nos mostró Jesús. A veces los sacrificios que estamos llamados a hacer por los demás son pequeños. Pero estas pequeñas decisiones de amar y servir a los demás nos preparan para las decisiones y sacrificios más grandes que se nos pida hacer. Si somos personas que hemos practicado mostrar nuestro amor por los demás con generosidad, también seremos personas que estamos dispuestas a dar la vida por aquellos a quienes amamos.

A medida que se reúnan en familia, hablen sobre el significado de la palabra *generosidad*. Pida a cada miembro de la familia que describa una acción que demuestre generosidad. Ser generoso es dar libremente a los demás sin contar el costo. Recordemos que la generosidad es uno de los frutos del Espíritu Santo. Introduce la lectura del Evangelio de hoy diciendo que Jesús nos enseñó a ser generosos al mostrar nuestro amor los unos por los otros. Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Juan 15:9-17. ¿Qué ejemplos nos dio Jesús que muestran esta clase de amor? (lavando los pies de sus discípulos; aceptando la muerte en la cruz) Jesús nos ayuda a mostrar este tipo de amor a los demás. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús prometió que Dios nos dará todo lo que pidamos. Una de las cosas que podemos pedirle a Dios es un espíritu generoso para que podamos amar a los demás como lo hizo Jesús. Concluyan en oración juntos rezando la Oración por la Generosidad de San Ignacio de Loyola.
